

Climate Zones

Over the past years Australia has experienced some extreme weather from droughts to significant rainfall. The climatic tolerances of a variety must be measured not just according to temperature extremes, but also by seasonal rainfall patterns. The map shows four major climatic zones for the Australian continent.

As a standard, zones 2 and 4 have wet summers while zones 1 and 3 have wet winters. To assist in variety selection please review the Variety Specification Sheet, which shows the recommended zones for each variety.




Black Jack





Winner of the Chelsea Flower Show 2023, Black Jack is a stand out variety of Agapanthus with deep purple flowers and buds that appear almost black. The plant has a vigorous habit, and is highly floriferous, producing dense umbels with a high number of inflorescenses. A reblooming variety with an extended flowering period from Spring through to Autumn. Developed in South Africa, Black Jack is heat and drought tolerant.

Schizachyrium 'Chameleon' has multi-colored, showy foliage during the seasons: green-white striped variegated foliage in Spring and early Summer that changes to pink and purple in Autumn. 'Chameleon' flowers in Autumn with purple-red flowers. The habit is compact, upright and dense. 'Chameleon' grows up to about 1m tall and 50cm wide.
