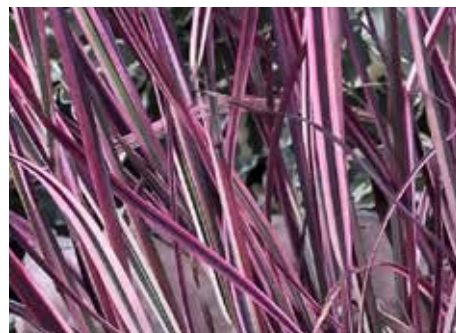



# Climate Zones

Over the past years Australia has experienced some extreme weather from droughts to significant rainfall. The climatic tolerances of a variety must be measured not just according to temperature extremes, but also by seasonal rainfall patterns. The map shows four major climatic zones for the Australian continent.

As a standard, zones 2 and 4 have wet summers while zones 1 and 3 have wet winters. To assist in variety selection please review the Variety Specification Sheet, which shows the recommended zones for each variety.

Winner of the Chelsea Flower Show 2023, Black Jack is a stand out variety of Agapanthus with deep purple flowers and buds that appear almost black. The plant has a vigorous habit, and is highly floriferous, producing dense umbels with a high number of inflorescences. A re-blooming variety with an extended flowering period from Spring through to Autumn. Developed in South Africa, Black Jack is heat and drought tolerant.

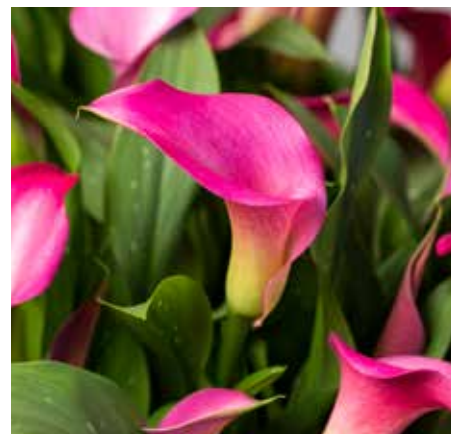

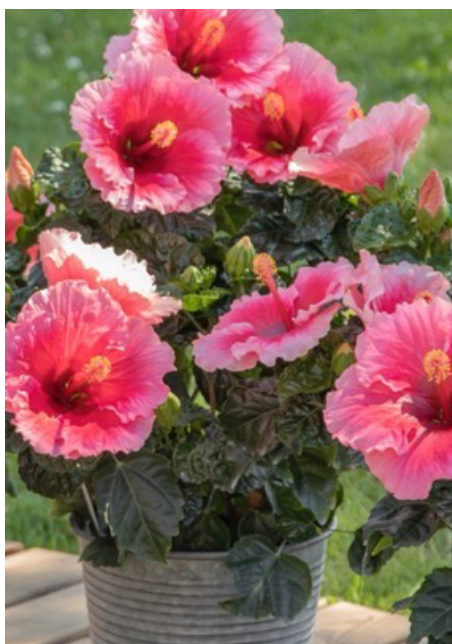

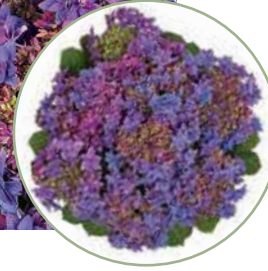

Japanese Holly Fern is a an attractive variety with dark green glossy leaves and serrated edges.

Hardy to -15°C, and incredibly tolerant of dry air, this fern is an excellent addition to indoor and landscape ranges.

Japanese Holly Fern is deciduous in cold climate areas but will remain evergreen in most moderate, temperate and tropical climates.



### East Indian Holly Fern

*Arachnoides simplicor*



East Indian Holly Fern is a handsome fern with hand-shaped, textured fronds that are glossy green with yellow variegation.

Hardy down to -23°C, and suited up to Ø 25cm pot, this fern is perfect for use in landscape or indoor applications.
