



Climate Zones

Over the past years Australia has experienced some extreme weather from droughts to significant rainfall. The climatic tolerances of a variety must be measured not just according to temperature extremes, but also by seasonal rainfall patterns. The map shows four major climatic zones for the Australian continent.

As a standard, zones 2 and 4 have wet summers while zones 1 and 3 have wet winters. To assist in variety selection please review the Variety Specification Sheet, which shows the recommended zones for each variety.

Black Jack





Winner of the Chelsea Flower Show 2023, Black Jack is a stand out variety of Agapanthus with deep purple flowers and buds that appear almost black. The plant has a vigorous habit, and is highly floriferous, producing dense umbels with a high number of inflorescences. A re-blooming variety with an extended flowering period from Spring through to Autumn. Developed in South Africa, Black Jack is heat and drought tolerant.

Blush Pink





Blush Pink is the first Agapanthus of it's kind - a consistently blush pink bi-colour! The plant has a compact habit with evergreen foliage that won't turn brown during the colder months. The buds appear beige/brown for a short period of time before opening to a light pink that develops into a darker pink as it ages.

Ice Angel™





Ice Angel[™] produces masses of white flowers during Spring to Summer. Repeat blooms appear throughout the seasons in most cases. Ice Angel has a semi-compact form with good disease resistance. Flowers 8 weeks earlier than the variety Snowball.





Ever Sparkle





Ever Sparkle is a fast growing bi-colour variety with dense inflorescences of violet-blue and white flowers on compact stems. Ever Sparkle has an extended flowering period and produces more flower heads than other varieties on the market. Ever Sparkle has a shorter flower stems than Fireworks and other alternative bi-colours on the market.

Milky Way





New finer leafed, clumping variety, with bright green and cream variegation. Milky Way is a tough, heat and drought tolerant plant that is excellent for landscaping applications. Brighter variegation than other *Dietes grandiflora* 'Variegata'.

Schizachyrium 'Chameleon' has multi-coloured, showy foliage during the seasons: green-white striped variegated foliage in Spring and early Summer that changes to pink and purple in Autumn. 'Chameleon' flowers in Autumn with purple-red flowers. The habit is upright and dense. 'Chameleon' grows up to about 1m tall and 50cm wide.






