Hydrangea Oriental Lace™



Hydrangea hybrid 'March4' (b)

Oriental Lace™ is an innovative new tropical hybrid Hydrangea which produces XXL Lace cap blooms with no winter vernalisation.

Unlike traditional Hydrangea varieties this unique new variety is suitable for growing in tropical areas including Queensland, due to not requiring any winter cold period to produce flowers. Oriental Lace™ will flower profusely in early in spring and will be followed up with more flowers through the summer and autumn. Oriental Lace™ is also very suitable for use as an indoor flowering decoration.

Oriental Lace's™ extra-large lace cap blooms can be produced pink or blue. Depending on how you grow it the plant will reach approximately 60cm high and 50cm wide in the garden. No specialised pruning is required due to its easy to flower nature.

This Hydrangea is available as plugs from autumn 2021 onwards.
